

ABOUT THE PROJECT:

Real Stories is a traveling art installation and spoken-word series amplifying the voices of college students facing homelessness and basic-needs insecurities. Each portrait and performance captures courage, creativity, and resilience.

This fall, we're bringing Real Stories outdoors for the first time, in collaboration with Third Thursday, Near Southside's signature art-walk event. The installation will transform the South Main micro-park into an open-air gallery, blending art, performance, and community engagement.

WHY IT MATTERS

In the wake of **Texas SB17**, legislation restricting Diversity, Equity & Inclusion programs on campuses, many students have lost access to spaces that affirm and protect them. Compounded with federal policies, hosting Real Stories at college campuses is no longer an option.


Real Stories at Third Thursday offers a new stage: a civic and cultural space where student champions can be their most authentic selves and where community members can stand in solidarity through art, empathy, and action. It is a space for us to continue our journey to raise awareness and drive change towards this critical topic.

THE VENUE

Third Thursday engages the vibrant network of businesses operating in Near Southside t to house artist and art work. Real Stories will occupy the micropark that anchors the entrance into South Main. The experience will engage patrons and gift them with an expanded awareness on the challenges students face as they pursue their education.
